Some of the activities encountered will include using and maintaining tools and equipment, testing and charging batteries and servicing braking systems.		
Entry Requirements	Successful completion of the first year of the 2 year course. It is essential that the learner/student establishes a genuine workplace relationship with an automotive business either through Structural Workplace Learning or part time employment. A contract of training (COT) (School Based Apprenticeship) is desirable.
