Practical activities include grooming (horses, alpaca and fowl) cleaning and feeding. Two field trips are included.																		
Pathways	Completion of this Qualification leads to Certificate II in Animal Studies and then on to Certificates III in Animal Studies, Captive Animals, Companion Animal Services, Veterinary Nursing or diploma or animal Technology. Employment opportunities includes veterinary practices, pet shops, boarding kennels, animal welfare organisations, biomedical research and production facilities, horse stables and wildlife parks.
