Course Description	This course is delivered one day per week with face to face one week and placement then following week. Placement will be organised for the students in a child care centre, working with a range of children of all ages.		
Pathways	This program prepares participants for employment in Children's Services sector. The Certificate III is the minimum entry level to work in the Children's Services. Graduates will be competent in a range of essential skills.		
Entry Requirements	Students require a DCSI child related employment screening in order to complete work placement. Schools will invoice students for the cost of this.		
Other Requirements	Students should have achieved at least a C standard in Year 10 English. Students are required to complete practical placement in a day care centre.
